son of Nancy and Glenn



Gary Jr., Gary Hunter Sr., and wife Nancy




house and some fishing in his free time. Congratulations, Gary!

Marko and Mara Subasic celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary on October 20, 2009. The happy couple is





#### AN IMPORTANT **RERUN MESSAGE**

The following article is a "rerun" from our summer 2006 newsletter, but we feel that it bears repeating:

### How do I know when a toothache is serious enough to call the dentist?

So often we have people call the office who need to get in to see us immediately because of an excruciating toothache. We hate to see our patients in such pain, and we want to have ample time scheduled to treat the problem. If you are starting to feel a slight ache or a twinge of discomfort, it is best to call us as soon as possible. We always have time allotted in the afternoon for emergency visits, so if you call early in the morning, we can get you in that day to take care of the tooth before it escalates into a full-blown toothache. Minor discomfort may only require a filling, whereas severe pain may be an indication of the need for a root canal or extraction. Our best advice is don't wait until it's too late!

Sudden, severe pain or inflammation requires immediate attention. Do not hesitate to call our office at any time if this is what you are experiencing.

Also, regular checkups and x-rays at six-month intervals go a long way toward avoiding toothaches because we often can discover a problem and take care of it before it becomes painful.

# Crock-Pot shredded chicken for tacos

(a Weight Watchers recipe)

4 FROZEN skinless, boneless chicken breasts

1 16 oz. jar of salsa, mild or hot, whatever your preference

1 pkg. taco seasoning mix

Mix salsa and taco seasoning. Place in Crock-Pot.

Add 4 frozen chicken breasts.

Turn on low and cook for 8 to 10 hours.

Shred chicken with two forks.

Serve on tortillas or taco shells.

## Cream of wild rice soup

1 large onion, chopped

1 large carrot, shredded

1 celery rib, chopped

¼ cup butter

½ cup flour

8 cups chicken broth

1 Box Uncle Ben's Wild Rice, cooked

1 cup cubed cooked chicken breast

¼ tsp. salt

¼ tsp. pepper

1 cup fat-free evaporated milk

1/4 cup snipped chives, optional

In a large pot, sauté the onion, carrot, and celery until tender.

Stir in flour until blended.

Gradually add broth.

Stir in the rice, chicken, salt,

and pepper.

Bring to a boil over medium heat.

Cook and stir 2 minutes or

until thickened.

Stir in milk and cook 3 to 5 minutes longer.

Garnish with chives.
